### 1963 P.S.S.A. CONGRESS

THE 10th annual congress of the Photographic Society of Southern Africa took place in Johannesburg over a 4 day period and commenced with a film show organised by the Motion Picture Division in the Dorothy Suskind Hall on Friday evening the 30th August, 1963.

Following registration the next morning the opening ceremony was performed in the Cranbrooke Hotel by His Worship the Mayor of Johannesburg Councillor J. F. Oberholzer, M.P.C.

In his address the Mayor expressed surprise at the large number (133) of photographic clubs which were members of the P.S.S.A. He wished the Congress success and hoped that one day the excellent photographic museum started by Dr. A. D. Bensusan would be housed in a suitable building, perhaps even in the new Civic Centre.

The President of P.S.S.A., Dr. J. K. du Toit in his reply said that he hoped that the Congress would be the forerunner of other fruitful ones to be held in the City. He presented the Mayor with a P.S.S.A. badge as a souvenir of the occasion.

An excellent talk on Colour Print Production by Mr. Ted Dickinson followed and after lunch a large party set out for the Killarney Film Studios where the secrets of professional film making were exposed by Mr. P. Frenze. The tour included inspections of the studios, film processing laboratories and editing rooms and was highly instructive.

Cocktails were enjoyed late in the afternoon and during an excellent dinner the following awards were given:-

### Honorary Fellowship and Honorary Membership

Awarded to Dr. A. D. Bensusan (Johannesburg) as founder and architect of P.S.SA. and for quite exceptional services to all branches of photography in Southern Africa.

### Associateship

Awarded to Ludwig Blum of Johannesburg for a collection of boldly presented Natural History subjects of high pictorial merit.

Awarded to S.W.R. D'Elboux of Pretoria for a collection of 12, 4 x 5 inch colour transparencies of Industrial subjects of high quality.

Awarded to Monty Freeman of Johannesburg for 35mm colour slides being "Derivations" and "Bas reliefs" of pictorial subject matter, which presented unique effects.

#### Service Medals

Awarded to Dr. J. K. du Toit and Stephen D'Elboux of Pretoria for their work in connection with the 1962 Pretoria Congress and Protea Salon.

### Honorary Membership

Awarded to Robert Bell of Cape Town and Lionel Bevis of Durban in recognition of their past valuable services.

After dinner Dr. Plotkin presented an interesting and humourous talk, and slide show on his experiences with ten other South Africans in the Antartic. The highlights of the slide show were the spectacular sunsets and change in the colouring of the ice.

For those interested in taking photographs an early Sunday morning outing was organised by the Camera Pictorialists of Johannesburg and then followed by an excellent programme of inter-tribal Bantu dancing at the City Deep Compound where special facilities were offered to the photographers.

After a welcome lunch, members made a 35 mile trip to Pretoria to view the prints accepted for the


