ASSOCIATESHIP OF P.S.S.A.

THE letters A.P.S. (S.A.) designate an accomplished photographer. These letters following a person's name show that he (or she) has been awarded Associateship of the Photographic Society of Southern Africa.

Associateship is, however, within the grasp of every enthusiastic persevering photographer. It can be attained in any of the following categories: Monochrome Prints or Slides, Recorded Slide Programmes Colour Prints, Colour Slides, Ciné Films, Documentary or Literary, and for Service to Photography. Full information as to the requirements in each of these categories is furnished on the Society's Application for Associateship form, which is available on request from: Hon. Secretary, Honours and Awards Committee, P.S.S.A., P.O. Box 2007, Johannesburg. In the meantime, some idea as to the requirements in the more popular sections will enable some estimate as to the standard expected of applicants.

In the Colour Slide section, twelve transparencies must be submitted, preferably processed by the candidate. If trade processed slides are submitted, a higher standard is required. In the black and white, and colour print sections twelve mounted enlargements are required. The subject matter in both categories can be mixed, for example, portraits and natural history. In fact, this is preferred. Judges are then better able to assess the candidate's general ability than is possible from studying, for example, twelve portraits all taken with the same lighting setup.

Standard of work required is difficult to describe in words. However twelve enlargements or slides each of which have been accepted in at least one international salon, would be likely to succeed. The standard on which judges must base their decision is, however, clearly defined. "Somewhat higher than

that required by other international societies with a similar honour," states the application form.

Applications for associateship are considered *once* only every year. The work and completed application form must be in the hands of the Society in Johannesburg by June 15th.

FELLOWSHIP OF THE PHOTOGRAPHIC SOCIETY OF SOUTHERN AFRICA

AIM of new members at all camera clubs is for their prints and transparencies to be credited with gold stickers and Mark 1's. Then as they progress, they seek acceptance for their work in salons throughout the world.

Next rung of the success ladder is Associateship of Photographic Society of Southern Africa, and with it the internationally recognised honour of scribing after their names "A.P.S. (S.A.)."

Top of the ladder, and highest award for merit in photography which our national body can bestow is Fellowship, and the distinction of the letters F.P.S. (S.A.).

Fellowship is not easily attained. It is granted only to associates who have qualified in three sections. For example having qualified in the different sections of Colour Slides, Recorded Slide Programmes and Black and White prints. Applications can be made in all three sections at the same time, or over a period of years.

Applications for Associateship are considered once

only each year. They close on June 15th. Write to the Hon. Secretary, Honours and Awards Committee, P.S.S.A., P.O. Box 2007, Johannesburg, for application for associateship form containing full particulars.

P.S.S.A. LION TROPHY

THIS trophy is a 4½-inch silver-plated lion mounted on a mahogany base.

It will be awarded to all Salons that apply for P.S.S.A. approval, and receive such approval. The trophy is to be awarded to the most meritorious print or slide at the Salon, and at the Judges' discretion.

Clubs, in the future, are requested to apply for P.S.S.A. approval in order to qualify. Rules and regulations approving salons will shortly be circulated to all member clubs.
