# **Judging**

- Judging will be done "remotely". There will be three adjudicators per category per club.
- Each adjudicator will score every image out of 15. The sum of the
  three scores will represent the final score out of 45 per image. The
  winning image will be chosen by the judges in a second and third
  (if needed) round of judging. In the case of a tie the images may,
  at the salon director's discretion, be referred back to the
  adjudicators for a final verdict. The same applies to the runner up.
- The organising committee of each club will scan all the images beforehand to ensure conformance to the definition of a category.

Non-conformance may lead to disqualification. However, the judges will have the right to question any disqualification. This screening is being done in order to reduce the burden on the judge allowing him/her to rather concentrate on the pictorial/photographic merit of the image.

• Where two or more adjudicators are of the opinion that an image does not conform to the definition of the entered category, the image, in consultation with the salon director, will be disqualified.

# **Category descriptions**

# Category A: Nature Mammals (Colour only)

Images must be of wild, unrestricted mammals <u>in their natural environment</u> such that a well-informed person could testify to its true representation. Human elements shall not be present. The presence of scientific bands is acceptable. **No digital manipulation is allowed** (See definition p5).

## Category B: Nature Landscapes (Colour only)

Landscape is a term that covers the depiction of <u>scenery</u> such as mountains, valleys, the veld, trees, sea, rivers etc. The primary subject will be a <u>wide view</u> with elements arranged into a coherent composition. No man-made elements may be present. A horizon often (but not necessarily) forms part of a landscape. The presence of wildlife must be carefully considered. If the latter is present but such that it overwhelms the image it may not be regarded as a landscape anymore.

**Quote:** "It becomes something else when the dominant feature is not the scenery but some object (like wildlife) that makes the scenery of secondary importance."

No digital manipulation is allowed. (See definition p5)

# **Category C: Colour open**

Any colour image may be entered in this category as long as it does not conform to the requirements of the Landscape and Wildlife categories. There will be <u>no limitation</u> on the degree of digital manipulation.

# Category D: Black and White open.

This is a pure <u>Black and white only</u> section. <u>No</u> monochromatic toning e.g. Sepia is allowed. Subject material is open. However a black and white copy of a colour entry in any of the other sections will lead to disqualification of both entries. There will be <u>no limitation</u> on the degree of digital manipulation.

### Note:

Acceptances in this category will count towards the PSSA <u>Monochrome league</u> ranking for paid-up PSSA members.

### **Definition Black and White**

An image showing tones from the very dark grey (Black) to the very clear grey (white) with or without various shades of grey (including any border when present) will be a black and white image. An image which is <u>obviously</u> toned with an additional colour like e.g. Sepia (partially or wholly), may not be entered and will be disqualified.

## **DIGITAL MANIPULATION**

The following will **not** be considered as digital manipulation:

- Cropping and resizing
- Adjustment/correction of colour balance. Digital Colour filters such as cooling and warming filters may be used carefully.
- Removal of dust and scratch marks. Correcting Specific lens and sensor aberrations such as chromatic aberrations, etc.
- Any algorithm that will alter the exposure and contrast of the image; whether partially or to the image as a whole.
- Removal or reduction of digital noise and film grain.
- Any Sharpening algorithm, partially or to the whole image is permissible.
- Modern digital techniques such as HDR, Focus Stacking and Stitching where the end result is a faithful representation of the original scene are acceptable.

### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- Up to <u>four</u> images per category may be submitted. Note: If two or more images from the same entrant are similar (e.g. as a result of rapid continuous shooting), only the first image will be considered for acceptance and/or awards.
- The original image and all the elements therein must have been taken by the entrant. All actions in reaching the final presentation must have been made by the

entrant By virtue of submitting an entry, the entrant certifies the work as her/his own.

- Images must be resized to a maximum of 1024 px. on the horizontal axis and 768 px. on the vertical axis, (including borders if present). Files must be compressed to a maximum of 500 Kb in Jpg format.
- Images are to be entered "online" via uploading using **Photovault**. (www.photovaultonline.com).
- Offensive material: Any image that the salon director considers pornographic or offensive may be disqualified after consultation with the judges.
- **Note** that the salon director(s) may request proof of authenticity of all the elements in the submitted images. An entry in the salon will be disqualified if requested proof cannot be presented.
- The organisers assume no liability for any misuse of copyright by the entrant.

# **Entry Fee:**

- A. The entry fee, covering all three salons, is **R10.00 per image** for paid-up PSSA members.
- B. For non-PSSA members the fee will be R15.00 per image.
- C. R40.00 per CD catalogue containing all the accepted images
