Judging

- 1. Images will be judged by judges who has received their honours through PSSA or whom has attended both JAP (Judging Accreditation Program) workshops for this purpose and not by remote judging.
- 2. Where a majority of the adjudicators are of the opinion that an image does not conform to the definition of the entered category, the image will be rejected.
- 3. The judges will discus the short-listed images, to come to the conclusion for the winners as per the PSSA policy.
- 4. An image that, to the discretion of the salon director or the adjudicators, does not conform to the salon rules and conditions may be rejected.
- 5. Any image that the Salon Director considers pornographic of offensive to the public may, on consultation with the judges, be disqualified.
- 6. If two or more entries by an entrant are similar, only the first image receiving an acceptance will be considered for special awards.
- 7. All entrants may be requested to send their original unaltered photos for confirmation of ownership and digital manipulation performed on the final image in full resolution.

Salon Rules

- 1. Authors may submit up to four images per section.
- 2. The Salon will be managed with the Photovault Judging System. This means that all participants must REGISTER their entries on Photovault. Normal Photovault sized images (1024 x 768) in pixels will be accepted. This means that no image must exceed 1024 in the horizontal plane and 768 in vertical plane. This image is merely used as a reference for Salon management purposes and will not be seen by the Judges. By submitting images through Photovault, the hosting club will be able to compile a CD with the accepted and winning images for those who will be interested in buying a CD. The fees for a CD will be R30.00 per CD.

Only entries that is REGISTERED through Photovault will be JUDGED. The DIGITAL IMAGE is only a REGISTRATION and the physical PRINT must be mailed to the Salon Director as instructed elsewhere.

- 3. If two or more entries from the same author (even in different categories) are similar, only the first one receiving an acceptance will be eligible for exhibition and/or award.
- 4. Entry fees is as follows:

Sufficient additional postage or a self addressed envelope must accompany all entries. Courier returns must have a waybill together with account number or courier fees should accompany your entry. Please note: The entry fees does not include return postage or courier fees for the returning of prints.

- 5. Prints must not be mounted, a 5mm border is suggested for display pegs.
- 6. Maximum size of prints: 10" x 15" (254mm x 381mm). Approximately A3 Minimum size of prints: 8" x 12" (203mm x 305mm). Approximately A4
- 7. A self adhesive label (see below) with the following information must be on the back of each print.

- 10. As per PSSA guidelines, no direct family member of any of the judges will be allowed top awards for specific Salon category judged by the family member.
- 11. The medal for "Most Successful Junior" will go to the junior (1 to 3 star club rating) with the most salon points. Authors with PSSA honours are not eligible for the Junior medals.
- 12. Entries received without proof of payment, insufficient fees or incomplete entry forms will not be received. judged or exhibited, nor will they be returned until sufficient fees to cover return postage are received.
- 13. Regarding any judgement call needed to be made on the day of salon judging of all entries, the decision of the Salon Director will be final.
- 14. While the utmost care will be exercised whilst handling entries, the organizers cannot accept liability for any loss or damage that may occur.
- 15. Submission of entries signifies acceptance of the conditions of entry.
- 16. No late entries will be accepted, judged or exhibited.

Categories and Definitions

Human Portraits

A likeness, personality, and mood of a living subjest where that subjest is dominant in the image. Portrature is not restricted to head and shoulders and may include just a part of the face, a back view or even a full length study. Manipulation will be allowed.

Pictorial/Open

For General Photography, there is no restriction on subject. Images deemed as Human Portraits, Photo Journalism or Nature will not be allowed in this category. Manipulation will be allowed.

Sport

Sports Photography covers any aspect of a sporting event. Images must depict an active pastime or recreation involving physical exertion and/or skill that is governed by a set of rules or customs and often of a competitive nature. Manipulation will not be allowed.

Nature

Images must be of animals, birds, insects, reptiles or marine life in a natural surrounding such that a well informed person could testify as to its true representation. Images depicting cultivated plants, domestic animals, still life studies, mounted specimens or museum exhibits are not allowed. Manipulation will not be allowed.

Final Notes

- 1. All images submitted in this salon shall originate as photographs by the entrant either digitally or on photographic film.
- 2. By virtue of submitting an entry, the photographer certifies the work as his/her own.
- 3. The entered material may be used free of charge for publication or display in media related to the salon, including posting on a web site.
- 4. Great care will be taken to protect the authors' intellectual property, however, this salon cannot assume liability of any misuse of copyright. The use of the images shall be restricted to judging, subsequent printing in the (electronic and hard copy) catalogue, display/exhibition of the accepted images and winning images might be printed in the Image magazine.
