Judging

1. Images will be adjudicated via Remote Judging with three judges per category.
2. Where three or more adjudicators are of the opinion that an image does not conform to the definition of the entered category, the image will be rejected. In the case where two or less adjudicators are of the opinion that an image does not conform to the definition of a specific category, the average point of the remaining adjudicators will represent the final score.
3. The judges will discuss the shortlisted photos to come to a conclusion for the winners as per the PSSA policy.
4. An image that, to the discretion of the salon director or the adjudicators, does not conform to the salon rules and conditions may be rejected.
5. Any image that the Salon Director considers pornographic or offensive to the public may, on consultation with the judges, be disqualified.
6. If two or more entries by an entrant are similar, only the first image receiving an acceptance will be considered for special awards.
7. All entrants may be requested to send their original unaltered photos for confirmation of ownership and digital manipulation performed on the final image in full resolution.

Entry fees

1. The entry fee covering all three salons, is R10.00 per image for paid –up PSSA members.
2. For non PSSA members the fee will be R 15.00 per image.

Categories & definitions

Category 1– Panoramic Scapes (Digital Manipulation not allowed)(only color images)

An image with elongated fields of view, with an aspect ratio of 2:1 or larger, the image being at least twice as wide as its height.

Category 2– Portraits (Digital Manipulation allowed) (only color images)

A likeness, personality, and mood of a living subject where that subject is dominant in the image. Portraiture is not restricted to head and shoulders and may include just a part of the face, a back view or even a full length study.

Category 3 – Wildlife (Digital Manipulation not allowed))(only color images)

Falling within the Nature category is WILDLIFE which is defined as one or more organisms living free and unrestrained in a natural or adopted habitat.

- Therefore, while photographs of zoo or **any other animals in captivity**, insects or other creatures photographed in the studio or other controlled locations are NATURE subjects they are not WILDLIFE and could not be entered in a Wildlife section. **Animals living free and unrestrained on game farms, private game reserves and National Parks are considered to be wildlife.**

NOTE: Wildlife subjects are not limited to birds and mammals. Insects, reptiles, amphibians, sea creatures and botany are also eligible wildlife subjects as long as they are not captive subjects. The main subjects must be living organisms therefore Landscapes are not eligible wildlife subjects.

Category 4– Open (Digital Manipulation allowed)(only color images)

In this category the subject matter is totally open.

- All acceptance points accumulating from non nature sections will count in the open section.

- All elements must be photographic – if graphic elements are included they should enhance the photographic image but not take over from it. All graphics used should be created by the photographer using their own artwork.

Category 5– Photo Journalism (Digital Manipulation not allowed) (only color images)

An image that tell a news story. Photojournalism is distinguished from other close branches of photography by the qualities of:

- **Timeliness** — the images have meaning in the context of a recently published record of events.
- **Objectivity** — the situation implied by the images is a fair and accurate representation of the events they depict in both content and tone.

Narrative — the images combine with other news elements to make facts relatable to the viewer or reader on a cultural level

Conditions of entry

1. Each author may submit a maximum of 4 Digital Images in each category.
2. All entries must be resized to a maximum of 1024 pixels on the horizontal axis and a maximum 768 pixels on the vertical axis.
3. The inclusion of a frame or border is permissible as long as it remains within above mentioned size restriction.
4. Files must be saved in the JPEG format and once compressed should be no larger than 500kb.
5. It is recommended that the image be converted to the sRGB colour profile to ensure correct colours during display and judging.
6. All entries to be entered electronically via <http://www.photovaultonline.com> only.
7. Please remember to finalise your entry on Photovault after images were uploaded.
8. An acknowledgement of receipt of such entry will be returned to the entrant. If no confirmation is received within three working days the participant should contact the salon administrator or director.
9. Entries not received by the cut-off time will not be accepted.
10. It is very important to indicate you name and surname as reference when electronic payments are made.
11. Submission of entries signifies acceptance of and compliance with all the conditions of entry.

Digital Manipulation

The following will not be considered as digital manipulation:

1. Removal of dust and scratch marks on scanned images or spots from dust particles on the CCD/CMOS sensors of digital cameras. Specific lens/sensor aberrations such as chromatic aberrations and purple fringing may also be corrected/ removed.
2. Adjustments to exposure and contrast. This includes all algorithms that represent some form of dodging and burning.
3. Adjustment/correction of colour balance. This can either be done by selecting an appropriate white balance during the conversion in the RAW images, or by adding/subtracting colours in the photo editing software. The post capture application of digital colour correction filters like warming or cooling filters, similar to the 81 and 82 series of filters, is allowed.
4. Application of colour saturation. Non-selective saturation that is applied to the whole image is permissible.
5. Reduction of digital noise, especially in high ISO images from digital cameras, or film grain in scanned images.

6. Sharpening of the image. All modern sharpening algorithms and techniques such as edge sharpening, luminance sharpening and mode sharpening are permissible.
7. Cropping and resizing is permissible.
8. Compositing, multiple exposures, sandwich/montage shots and double exposures are classified as digital manipulation.
9. Digital techniques such as HDR, stacking and stitching where the end result is a faithful representation of the original scene is not seen as digital manipulation.

Closing notes

1. All images submitted in this salon shall originate as photographs by the entrant either digitally or on photographic film.
2. By virtue of submitting an entry, the photographer certifies the work as his/her own. No clip art, digital art or photographs other than those made by the entrant may be used in whole or in part in any portion of the image. Images may only be manipulated as noted in individual category definitions. Manipulation should never be used to the extent that the main theme of the image becomes unrecognizable.
3. The entered material may be used free of charge for publication or display in media related to the salon, including posting on a web site. The salon assumes no liability of any misuse of copyright.
4. Reasonable care will be taken to avoid the misuse of the images or the unauthorized distribution of the submitted images. The use of the images shall be restricted to judging and subsequent display/exhibition of the accepted images.
