

PSSA Guidelines: Youth Division

The following guidelines are proposed to schools for the award of full colours of honour and half colours of honour during the schools' annual awards evenings:

1. Half Colours of Honour

In order to receive Half Colours of Honour the candidate must fully comply with all of the following criteria:

- An active participation of at least 80% of the Photography/School club events.
- An active participation in the biannual Up-and-Coming salon events.
- An active participation in other national and/or international salons and competitions.
- Must have received at least 10 acceptances in any of the salons.

2. Full Colours of Honour

In order to receive Full Colours of Honour the candidate must fully comply with all of the following criteria:

- An active participation of at least 80% of the Photography/School club events.
- An active participation in the biannual Up-and-Coming salon events.
- An active participation in other national and/or international salons and competitions.
- Must have received a Certificate of Excellence from the Photographic Society of South Africa.
- Must have received at least 25 acceptances in any of the salons.
OR
- Must have received at least 15 acceptances in any of the salons.
AND
- Must have received an award in any of the salons/competitions during the school year: An award can be any one of the following:
 - a medal,
 - a Certificate of Merit,
 - a plaque, or
 - 1st, 2nd, 3rd place certificate as an award in international competition.

It is the prerogative of the school to decide if an individual must accumulate the above mentioned during one school year or allow the individual to accumulate this over more than one school year.
