

### HOPE - an International Audio Visual Salon

According to ChatGPT-OpenAI:

There is only one category - 'Open' with the theme of 'Hope'


#### **Best entry award**

Entrants/Groups/Clubs may submit only **one** AV each with a maximum duration of 12 minutes.

COPYRIGHT: By virtue of submitting an entry, the entrant certifies the work as his/her own with declared co-authors and collaborators. The use of third party images, graphics, video clips or other visual material, should be appropriate to the production.

By participating in this salon authors of Audio Visual sequences indemnify the organisers against all and any action that may be taken against them by copyright owners. The organisers will accept no responsibility in the case of dispute or litigation.

PERMISSION: Entering this salon implies permission for successful sequences to be projected during the Zoom awards show.

The jury's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.



Dimensions: up to 1920 x 1080 px (16:9 aspect ratio) may be submitted.

Entries may be in either EXE or MP4 format. For possible inclusion in the award announcement Zoom meeting a MP4 version may be required.
