

Set Subjects for 2024-2025

June 2024	Tabletop/still-life	A still life features an arrangement of inanimate objects as its subject. The subjects may be man-made or natural and may be set up or found, indoors or out. Table Top –An arrangement of inanimate objects on a table top. Image can be Colour and Monochrome and is manipulation allowed.	YΔC
July 2024	The colour blue	A photo of an object or scene where the predominant colour is blue. Colour only and manipulation is allowed	Yes
August 2024	Textures	Your image must capture life and vibrance of texture on the surface of an object. Monochrome or Colour and manipulation is Allowed.	Yes
September 2024	Panning	Panning photography is a type of action shot. In essence, it's a kind of motion blur photography. It's when the photographer uses a relatively slow shutter speed to capture a moving subject, by moving the camera along with the subject. The end result is a sharp subject and a blurred background. It's a useful technique to know if you want to isolate a subject and make them stand out from the background. It's also an effective way of showing motion in a still image.	Yes
October 2024 Monochrome portraits		Monochrome is a black and white image. A black and white work fitting from the very dark grey (black) to the very clear grey (white) is a monochrome work with the various shades of grey. A black and white work toned entirely in a single colour will remain a monochrome work able to stand in the black and white category.	Yes
November 2024 Reflections		A reflection is an image seen in a mirror or shiny surface, e.g. Water may reflect the vegetation and sky if there is no disturbance in the surface.	Yes
December 2024	Christmas	Anything related to Christmas E.g. Christmas decorations	Yes



Set Subjects explained

In order to stimulate and give members a photographic purpose, 12 prescribed subjects are set for each year. One of your three entries per month may be entered into the set subject category.

Scoring and commenting is done as for open judging and the awards received are added to the club and personal logs. In addition, a winner and runner-up are chosen by the judges and the winner receives 3 points and the runner-up receives 2 points on the set subject log. All those entering receive 1 point on the set subject log. Images may be either Black & White or colour and manipulation is allowed (unless otherwise stated). Where no definition is given you are free to interpret the subject as you wish while still paying attention to the topic.

Fixed Set Subject - 2024

The 2024 Fixed set subject is a panel of images, the subject selected from **one** of this year's **set subjects**. There are no boundaries so you can choose any <u>six</u> images that you believe will go together. The only thing that you need to remember is that the 6 images must relate to one of the set subjects and they need to be images you have **not submitted before**. (I add the full number of Set Subjects for 2023-2024 for your convenience. Ed.) Last chance to enter your panel of 6 images is **3/7/2024**.

That is two images that have been exhibited at the club between July 2023 to June 2024 plus the 2 rehashed images. For your rehashed image please put the image title first then the word **rehashed** next. eg children at play rehashed. Last chance to enter Images and corresponding Rehashed images is 26/6/2024.


