Message from the President - Simon Fletcher APSSA, EPSSA(CIs), DPSSA(Vers), EFIAP

Welcome to another bumper edition of the Honours e-Image.

Firstly, to our Editor in Chief and Honours Chairperson Jill Sneesby, who has yet again done a sterling job of culminating your hard work into this wonderful and professionally created 2024 Honours publication.

Secondly, to you, our PSSA members, who have put in many hours of challenging work to furnish the honours panel your selected images in pursuit of your photographic honours. Well done and thank you for gracing us with your images for review, critique and award.

Without our honours judges who, for a whole weekend, twice a year, offer up their valuable time and energy to evaluate and judge your panels, a great amount of praise and gratitude is also warranted to them. Without these ladies and gentlemen, honours would not function as one of the cornerstones of PSSA.

Not the easiest of things to achieve is one's photographic honours. The day you decide you want to achieve your honours is the day your journey commences. A journey that, if I may say, is not easy at all. A lot of demanding work, in some cases tears and heartbreak, are often associated with honours, but in the long run, once you have achieved your honours, you will know the journey was well worth it. It is not a race but rather a celebration of one's growth as a photographer with visible evidence of personal growth.

Once confirmation is received that your honours panel has been accepted, not only is there joy but a sense of relief! Some may say that was a hard but satisfying journey, whereas others may have a far more stressful experience. Whatever your experience is, know that the honours judges and the process that is taken is there to get you through to the other side with a panel that you can seriously be proud of.

If you do not get your panel first time round (also a myth that happens often), you should not get upset with yourself. The standard for each of the levels of photographic honours has a minimum standard which is determined by a whole range of factors. These factors range from the overall quality and impact of each image to that of a panel that flows – many have said they are not in agreement with the flow concept, but quite honestly, this is where a lot of people miss the point.

Like with most things in life, flow is an important concept. It talks to the overall impression that the panel has to the creative flow of the images working in harmony with each other to create a panel of images that reflects your growth and progression as a photographer through the various honours levels.

Time is a crucial factor and element – and the simple reason for this is that it should show your growth in your photographic journey. The skills, the artistic flair, the technical mastery of the genre to the progression and apex of one's own work at a point in time!

It therefore stands to reason that through this natural progression of the various honours levels, you as a photographer have grown, enhanced and sharpened your photographic skill set that is demonstrated in your final panel award. Then, reflecting on your earlier work or panels, one should be able to see that there have been enhancements of skills as an overall package deal.

So, coming back to flow, you will, once you stop and think about it, realise that it is actually a crucial element. It is a sort of balance, an appeal and storyline that is being displayed so that the viewer can visually see your hard work in a manner that is pleasing, harmonious and flowing gently much like a river stream from the waterfall to the slow flow of water over smooth rocks and pebbles.



With that viewpoint, should you be starting with your honours distinctions or applying for the next level, think carefully and logically about your panel and tap into the numerous resources available to you.

Experienced photographers with their honours or even one of the honours judges – we are all into photography for the love of the art form and for the camaraderie it creates. But bear this in mind, it is not a personal slight when you do not achieve your honours first time round. Remember it is a journey, one you have decided to start and should follow to its logical conclusion – albeit through the tough discussions or realization that new, better images are required. The end product of the fruits of your labour should be outweighed once your final panel has been awarded and you look at it with well-deserved pride in this publication, the Honours Image. You would want it to be perfect to show off to your family and friends – this is the context in which you should view your photographic honours journey.

I hope you, our valued member of the PSSA family, will enjoy the accepted panels presented herein just as much as I have. Thank you for your ongoing support of the national body and for presenting your images for Honours distinctions.

Honours may be applied for either by submitting a panel for judging by a panel of judges or by achieving salon acceptances.

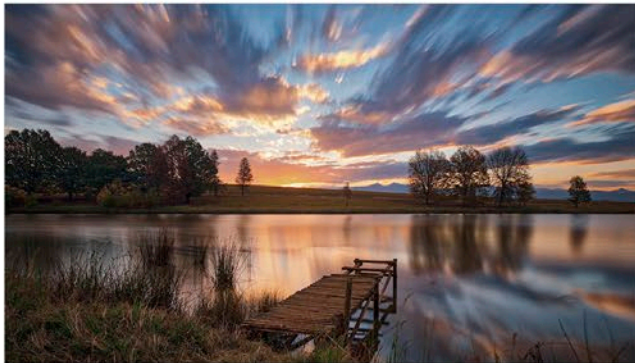
