## Inaugural General Meeting of the Cape Photographers

Saturday 20 March 1999 - Calitzdorp High School

Jill Sneesby, as the chairman for the meeting, welcomed 40 members to the meeting, (as per attendance register) and gave apologies from Dinkie Marais and Colla Swart.

- The first issue was deciding on a name for the new organisation. After some discussion and various suggestions having been put forward the majority vote went to the name Cape Photographers.
- The objects of the club were primarily to promote photography in the Cape on a club and individual level and to give the area a say and direct input to the national body PSSA. Clubs would join for a yearly fee and individuals were also encouraged to join, particularly if one did not already belong to a club.
- PSSA is now divided into regions and with the regional directors it is hoped that more feed back will be forthcoming. PSSA also needs help from the clubs to give impetus to any problems, and to make it aware of the clubs needs and wishes. Some felt that there were clubs who seemed unaware of PSSA or what it was supposed to achieve.
- As far as the Cape Photographers are concerned, the member clubs must now come forward with suggestions for improved communication and any ideas for the general administration that will improve the lot of the photographer. As an example, it was suggested that there could be some fine tuning for people moving from club to club so that the person did not have to be demoted, particularly if it was within the same area.
- It was also suggested that any member of PSSA from outside the area be used at club level if visiting. Any input from travelling folk would be welcome. Again communication and knowledge was needed for this to work.
- PSSA is mainly driven by competition but is now trying to promote photography which is non-competitive - namely visual art. Input from the clubs and individuals is badly needed for this theme to get off the ground.
- It was suggested that within the Cape region clubs organise competitions and possibly have a roving exhibition so everyone has the chance to see the work being done.
- With regard to the mini congress, planned to be held each year, clubs could each produce a 10 minute presentation, to show the work being done and to promote the club.
